How many mobile base stations are there in the UK?

The number of mobile base stations providing 5G services has more than doubled over the last year to over 6,500 sites across the UK - 87 percent of these are in England, 8 percent in Scotland, 3 percent in Wales and 2 percent Northern Ireland.

Does London have 5G?

Indeed, the underground's 5G is often faster and more reliable than that on the surface in central London. You'll get a phone signal so long as you're on one of the four UK networks: EE, Vodafone, Three and VMO2. Your phone should automatically connect, and there is no extra charge.

What is the fastest 5G network in the UK?

Three claims to be the fastest UK 5G network and it provides 99.8% of the outdoor population with 3G and 4G in the UK. In October 2020, Three was found to have 4G download/upload speeds on 22.2/8.0Mbps with 48.3ms 4G latency. Nearly 99% of the outdoor population is covered by O2's 3G and 4G.

Will 5G get through your walls?
